MINUTES OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING, 10 JULY 2024

1a. Apologies for Absence

Prior to noting apologies for absence, David Halford expressed his thanks to Eileen Oakley, for her work in setting up the Zoom session which enabled the meeting to be held online and to Sue Deakin, for her work in managing the club website and enabling members to reference the reports to the meeting with ease.

Apologies were received from 43 members. David made specific reference to comments made by Bob Law in tendering his apologies, in which Bob thanked the Club Committee for all their work during the past year. David commented that he would return to this during his annual report.

2. <u>Minutes of Annual General Meeting Held on 5 July 2023</u>

The minutes were accepted as a true and accurate record of the meeting.

3. <u>Matters Arising From 2023 Annual General Meeting</u>

No matters were raised by Club Members.

4. Report of Club Chairman

David Halford presented his annual report to the meeting. The report comprised a review of the recently finished club year and a selection of the highlights from the year. It also comprised an assessment of the strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and threats facing the club over the medium term. In particular, he commented that the club now has 117 members, an all time record, and continued very satisfactory participation.

David drew out his main conclusion from the report which was that the club continues to prosper and develop. He thanked each individual member of the Committee for their major contributions to the success of the club. He also thanked club members for their loyalty and support, without which the club could not achieve the success outlined in the report.

5. Report of Club Treasurer - Financial Statements at 31 March 2024

The strength of the financial position had enabled the club to reduce membership subscriptions for 2024/25. Belinda thanked Jane Somervell for undertaking her annual audit of the financial statements in a timely manner.

The new document reflects the situation where a very significant proportion of the bridge provided by the club is online using RealBridge. The new document contains all of the guiding principles to enable the club to continue to operate efficiently and effectively.

Club Members **APPROVED** the adoption of the updated and modernised Club Constitution.
