Supplementary Information

Checkback responses: after 2/3♣ checkback, responses of a major show 4 in that suit, 3 if the suit has been bid by partner, or 5 of suit has already been bid by NT bidder.

Game tries: after suit agreement, a bid of a new suit at the 3 level is invitational to game, requesting support/stops in bid suit, and forcing for 1 round.
