Opening bid of 2 H in $1^{\text {st } / 2^{\text {nd }} / 3^{\text {rd }} \quad \text { seats at all vulnerabilities }}$
Shows: A weak hand with either spades, or both hearts+clubs

## Detailed Description:

Vul, the style is sound:

- 5-10 and a reasonable six-card spade suit; or
- 6-11 and $5 / 5$ in hearts+clubs (can be a little less with $6 / 5$ shape). No promises made about the quality of either suit

NV , the hearts+clubs hand is still quite sound ( $5-10$ points, $5+/ 5+$ shape), but the spade hand is much more aggressive (QT9xx s xxxx xxx would be a clear 2 H opening $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{NV}$. In $2^{\text {nd }}$ seat, QT9xx would still be a very acceptable suit, but the expectation would be for the hand to be stronger than this).
Outside defence is quite possible, even with only a five-card suit, so long as the suit itself is up to scratch (which is measured based more on interior strength rather than top cards - - QT8xx is suitable but AJxxx is not).

## Responses and Rebids in Uncontested auctions

With what hands will responder pass the opening bid? Vul: usually own suit, or e.g.
2H 1-2C staying low opposite 5H5C. NV: Many weak hands that can't "further the preempt"
Meanings of other responses and rebids: 2 N INV+ask now $3 C=\min w / H+C, 3 D=$ non-min $w /$ spades, $3 H=$ max $w /$ hearts + clubs, $3 S=$ min $w /$ spades, $3 N=$ max $w / C+6$ hearts
4 C asks handtype and wants to be declarer if playing 4 S now $4 \mathrm{D}=$ hearts + clubs, $4 \mathrm{H}=$ spades.
3C NF. Others upto 4H PoC, but 2H-P-2S could be a hand intending to rebid 3S "to play". 2H-P-3C-P; 3D $=$ maximum weak two in spades

## Competitive Agreements

Responses after opponent's DBL
(including Pass, RDBL and expected follow-ups)
Pass $=$ to play opposite 5 H 5 C .
RDBL = "I have my own suit, please bid step 1". Bids are PoC
After 2H-P-P-dbl: now pass = 2+hearts now responder's rdbl and $2 S$ are PoC; opener's rdbl $=$ SOS
Responses after opponent's overcall:
$\mathrm{Dbl}=$ pens of diamonds and NT, and 4S or higher. PoC otherwise. Bids are PoC
Rebids after $4^{\text {th }}$ hand DBLs the response:
As if it wasn't doubled

## Rebids after $4^{\text {th }}$ hand overcalls:

Opener passes unless responder has shown a fit for their suit e.g. 2H-P-3C-3D, where the PoC 3C bid shows heart support.

## Proposed Defence

DBL $=$ takeout of spades
$2 \mathrm{~S} / 4 \mathrm{~S}=$ natural, but beware there may be spades on your right
Others = as if over a weak 2 S opening, including Leaping Michaels (this should be very sound)
After 2H-P-2S:
$4 \mathrm{~S}=$ natural, otherwise as versus a weak 2 S . Start by passing when holding a t/o dbl of hearts+clubs.
After 2H-P-P:
Opener VUL: $\mathrm{dbl}=\mathrm{t} / \mathrm{o}$ of hearts. Opener NV: $\mathrm{dbl}=$ takeout of spades.
$2 \mathrm{~S} / 4 \mathrm{~S}=$ natural, but beware there may be spades on your left.
Others $=$ as if over a weak 2 S opening
