Supplementary Notes Fitzpatrick – KellyRogers:

Drury

2♣ by passed hand over 1M (3rd or 4th hand) is artificial, promises 3 card support 8/11 points.

2♦ 4 card support 7/11 pts (Opener -cue bid or 2NT asking for shortness)

Resp If bid shortness max but could not open

3M weak

3NT best hand no shortness)

2♥/♠ 3/4 card support 6/9 pts (2NT asks if max - if so bid game)

(NB 1NT by passed hand now 6 - 9pts denying 3 card support

2NT natural 10/11 pts not 3 card support).

Bergen Raises after 1 of a Major Opening by partner:

always on after interference

- 1) 2♠ - Dbl – P a 3 level bid is 7/8 count, 3♣/3♦/3♥ are all 5 card suits. If partner bids 2NT over the Dble this is a transfer to 3♣ - which could be passed by a weak hand with ♣s. Over 3♣s if partner bids 3♦ or 3♥, these are to play and show a hand with 5♦s and 5(or 4)♥s and less than 6HCP.
