

Brd 1: (Vul: None, Dir N Decl N) Stayman, cross ruff

North East South West

1NT P 2C (stayman) P

2S P 4S All Pass

Lead Card: ♠Q by East (top of touching honours)

Expected Results: after pulling trump twice & realising

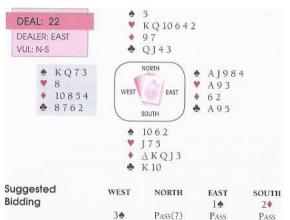
West is out has the 4 highest trump remaining

(assuming East has won a trick with SA). North then

cross-ruffs the 2 losing clubs & ◆s to make 10 tricks.

Defence: East should hold up SA until 2nd round &

then play another spadeto stop cross ruffing

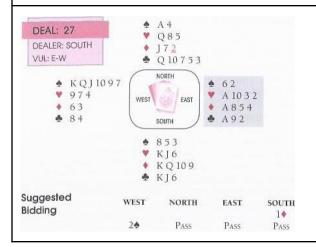


Brd 2: (Vul: NS, Dir E Decl E)

Ruff in short hand before drawing all trumps

Lead: South leads DA, DK & then DQ

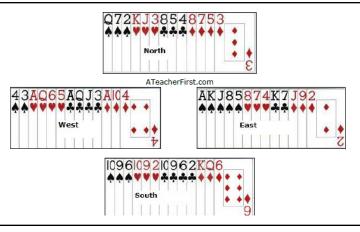
Play: East has 2 heart losers & needs to ruff these in Dummy. East ruffs 3rd round of ◆s, play HA & then leads low heart



Brd 3: (Vul: EW, Dir S Decl W) Weak Two overcall

Lead: North leads ◆2 (low from honour in partner's suit)

Play: Win first round & draw trumps immediately. Will win 5 spades & 3 Aces



Brd 4: (Vul: All, Dir W Decl W) Hold Up or not, finessing

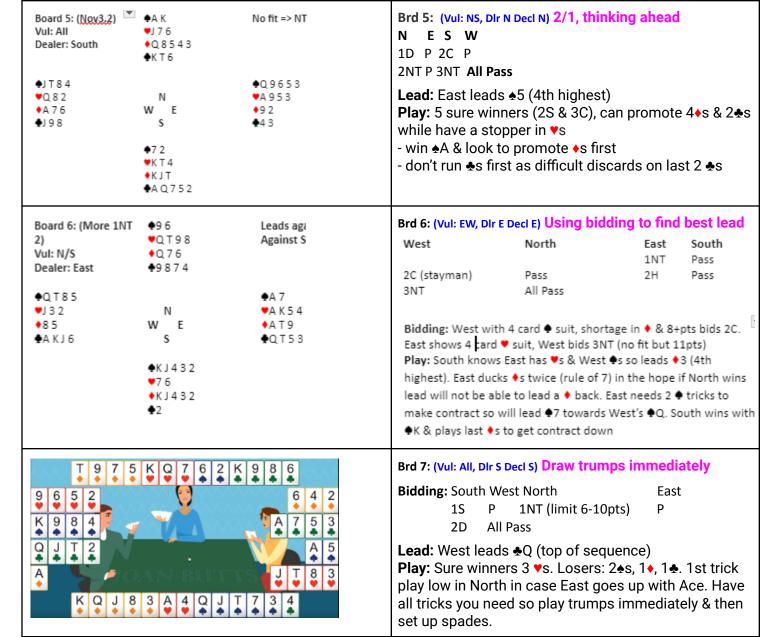

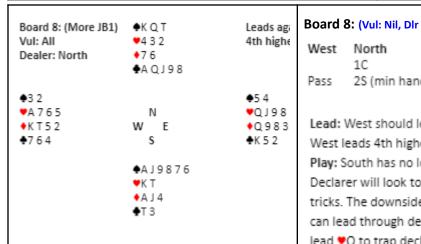

3NT All Pass

Lead: ◆8 "top of nothing". South will play high & West should play ◆A (don't "duck" as either ◆J or ◆10 will be a stopper & will win one more trick later)

Play: Winners: 4S (& maybe a finesse for 5th trick), 4C, 1H & 1 or 2Ds. West should try ♠ finesse (play ♠A first, then back to W's hand, lead a low ♠ to ♠K/J)





Board 8: (Vul: Nil, Dlr W Decl S) West Passes first Defence lead round to weakness

 Pass
 2S (min hand, only 3♠ but good ones)
 Pass
 4S - All Pass

Lead: West should lead a red suit. Rather than lead away from A in ♥s, West leads 4th highest ♦2 & East plays ♦Q - 3rd hand high.

Play: South has no losers in ♠s, maybe 2 in ♥s, 1 in ♦s & maybe 1 in ♠s.

Declarer will look to trump a ♦ in dummy & then look to ♠s for extra tricks. The downside is that if ♠ finesse fails & East wins with K then East can lead through declarer's ♥K. This is what happens & East should then lead ♥Q to trap declarer's K & E/W get 2 ♥ tricks to get contract 1 down.
