Play: Try ♥ finesse (fails); otherwise draw trumps & discard a D in North on a club

Note: E/W make 9 tricks so if discourage N/S from bidding 5H it will be a good result

Try the ♥ 10, which will force the ♥ A. Later when partner wins the ♠ K, you will be able to take three heart tricks, and the ♠ A and ♠ K to beat the contract.
