The Committee has the following information regarding resuming Face to Face Bridge at Maiden Place.

This list has been produced to try to limit risk as far as possible but of course it is not possible to entirely eliminate Covid risk.

We request that players are double vaccinated and bring their masks with them.

Please do not attend if you are unwell in any way e.g. cough or cold or if any of your contacts have had Covid in the past 14 days.

If you develop Covid during 14 days after playing, please advise the Committee immediately so that all players can be informed. It may be necessary to suspend Bridge for a week.

On arrival, keep greetings to a minimum and be seated as quickly as possible. Similarly, at the end of the session please leave the building promptly.

Weather permitting, windows and doors will be open during play, therefore please bear in mind that it may be cooler than usual.

The kitchen will not be available. Please bring your own refreshments. We will provide bottles of water and disposable cups for emergency use.

Hand sanitiser and wipes will be available on tables for use between games.

We would encourage the wearing of masks on arrival and departure and in communal areas (e.g. hallway and toilets). The wearing of masks when seated at the table is not necessary unless one or more of the players at the table requests it.

Bidding boxes and score cards will be available at the entrance for you to pick up on your arrival. (Please remember to bring your convention cards.)

East/West should take their bidding boxes with them to reduce the number of times a box is handled. Only one person at the table (typically North) should handle the Bridgemates. The results should be shown to East before pressing Accept.

At the end of the session, chairs (and tables belonging to Maiden Place) should be left out (for the caretaker to clean).

Please help with the putting away of playing tables.

We will not be collecting cash but will continue to invoice players as we have been doing for our online sessions.
