The spades are solid. A "second" of 8♠ shows a suit without honours. A "fourth" of 5♣ shows four or more card suit with at least one honour. However, the clubs have a large "gap" from A♣ to 10♣. Perhaps un-bid major is the better idea.</p> <p>West takes trick with Q♠. Trying the K♠ confirms four-card suit at East, so Playing the A♠ establishes partner's last spade.</p> <p>When West gets the lead, a heart switch is avoided to "protect" Q♥ and to avoid promoting K♥. The least worst is A♠ at least honestly promising the K and Q.</p> <p>East should signal an even number of cards by playing high low. This tells West to play all three honours establishing East's fourth spade.</p> <p>Looking at dummy East avoids diamonds because partner may have the K♦. Clubs are a fifty-fifty bet on the whereabouts of the ace. Hearts in dummy are quite poor, and a lead may find values in partner's hand. The least worst is A♠ at least honestly promising the K and Q.</p> <p>East should signal an even number of cards by playing high low. This tells West to play all three honours establishing East's fourth spade.</p> <p>East now avoids a diamond lead to protect the King. The clubs in dummy are weak so a club lead risks trapping any honours partner holds. The hearts in dummy are strong so a heart lead is unlikely to give anything away. The spades are solid. A "second" of 7♠ shows a suit without honours. The hearts have a broken sequence. Lead A♥. The Q♥ is not in dummy. Partner expects A♥ to show AKQ. If Partner has Q♥, they expect AKJ. They play Q♥ on the A♥ to show partner where it is.</p> <p>If Q♥ is not played by West, East knows North has it. The spades are solid. A "second" of 7♠ shows a suit without honours. The hearts are suitable for a 4<sup>th</sup> highest lead of 3♥. Best is probably the heart.</p> <p>Declarer's plan must rely on getting the lead to dummy and leading a diamond, preferably twice. He can do this with the clubs.</p> <p>South will get the lead twice, and lead hearts again. It's best to keep playing your side's suit. The spades are lovely, but short. There are four hearts but so poor any lead will look like a fourth highest and disappoint. The hand should get the lead four times, so at least can keep leading the hearts hoping for a 4:3:3:3 distribution. 5♥ it is.</p> <p style="margin: 0;">Partner will rise with the A♥ and seeing a short suit in dummy, return a heart. When declarer takes the trick, partner doubts the hearts.</p> <p style="margin: 0;">Declarer also has problems. They may well try to get the A♦ played, and the defence should hold it up.
