- ♣ Redouble following opponents take out double showing No Fit but Balance of Points
- ♣ Negative double ("Take Out") following partners suit opening and opponents suit overcall showing no five-card suit, 6-10HCP, generally support for two un-bid suits, four of any un-bid major
- ♣ Double of opponents' artificial suit bid to show suit and lead direction
- ♣ Following own suit opening, suit overcall by direct position opponent, and pass by partner, a double showing five of opening suit, shortage of opponents suit, tolerance for unbid suits, reopening the bidding

1. East X for Take Out, E/W Raise to game.
2. South X Take Out West XX to show Balance of Points.
3. North X for Take Out, E/W stretch to game.
4. West doubles 2C Stayman for lead.
5. East doubles 1NT for business South WTO.
6. West negative double.
7. South has a reopening double.
8. North "late" X to show spades.
