


East has a sensible take out double. With 12HCP, but no fit, South redoubles. West is too weak to come into the auction. North bids the second suit: hearts. South likes the fit, but with 8 losers, passes.

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
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
With a fit and points for game, this is not a redouble situation. West raises immediately to game.

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
North has a good redouble to show Balance of Points but no fit. South is wise to try 1NT as repeating the clubs after partner denies a fit is probably not good.

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
East's redouble shows that East/West has the balance of points, but no fit with opener's suit. South bids $1 \blacktriangle$ in response to partner's double and West rebids $2 \blacktriangledown$ in response to partner's redouble. West's raise to $3 \blacktriangledown$ should end the bidding.

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South is not strong enough to redouble. A raise to $2 \checkmark$ should be treated as less than 6HCP by North. West trusts partner for 4 spades and bids to the losing trick count.

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East's Spades aren't great, but there are five of them!

South has an excellent hand for a take-out double.

With 14HCPs, West redoubles to show balance of points and no fit with opener's suit.

North cannot bid.

East shows second suit, hearts.

It's a flat hand, West may invite to game, but it's a stretch.

With six losers, East may respond.

Knowing the South hand holds all the points may help, but it's tough to make.

South did suggest a holding of four hearts....

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
