The role entails:

- Negotiating rates with Suppliers (e.g. Power, Water, Broadband).
- Monitoring the Cash Flow in the Bank Account and providing the PMC with financial strategy.
- Recommending Salary levels for Bar Steward, Cleaner and Bookkeeper.
- Liaising with the Membership Secretary and the Bookkeeper regarding Subscriptions.
- Liaising with the Bookkeeper on a range of financial transactions.
- Presenting the monthly financial report (compiled by the Bookkeeper), with added comments, (via email) to the PMC.
- Transacting Club business at the PMC meetings (normally quarterly).
- Liaising with the Bridge Finance Officer, the Bowls Treasurer and the Bar Steward on relevant financial matters.

The role also carries the title of Officer of the Club. This entails:

• Liaising with the other Officers (President, Vice President, Gen. Secretary, Estate Manager) on a range of matters relating to the Club.
