

Social Bridge - How it Works

Social Bridge is available on Wednesday Evening from 6.00 pm onwards. It runs of RealBridge so you can see and chat to your friends. You have to organise as a group of four. You are welcome to invite friends who are not members to play.

- To get there click on the RealBridge logo at the top of the Carlton web site and click on the session link.
- If you are the first of your group to arrive sit at the first free table and await your friends. If one of your group is already there join their table. You first hand should be showing and you can start as soon as your friends arrive. There will be 20 boards available.
- There will usually be a Director available from 6.30 pm until around 8.00 pm if you have a problem. If there is no Director present, you could try emailing online@carltonbridge.co.uk.
- While the session is not scored as such, scores will show what other tables did on the hands. The scores on Realbridge now show a hand record and makeable contracts.
- After the Session is over, the Session Link becomes a link to the scores. The Session Links for previous sessions are shown under Result son the RealBridge page of the Carlton website.

Some tips on RealBridge:

- You need a good internet connection to play with video and sound. You may need to play near to your broadband router if you are using wi-fi as the walls in Edinburgh flats can cause problems with the signal.
- The Director can do very little to solve connection problems. If you have a problem, try refreshing your connection by clicking on the two arrows on the right of your name. If this doesn't work, try closing the browser tab running RealBridge and coming back in using the session link on the web site. Leaving the table and going into the lobby will not make any difference.
- You can play on RealBridge without video and sound. If you are having a connection problem, try turning off the video.
