# **Board Member Comments/Reports:**

- Ironman/Ironwoman Award. A motion was made and passed unanimously to add the following as Standing Rule 25.b.: The Ironman or Ironwoman Award shall be presented to the VCC member who played the most sanctioned club games in the previous calendar year.
- A motion was made to rescind the increase of fees from \$3 to \$5 for the joint games between VCC/LRDBC Bridge Clubs.
   Discussion centered on Standing Rule, Salary & Fee Schedule, Table Fees. The motion passed with one person abstaining.
- Regarding District 9's opportunity to include District 10 and 7 (0-99) players for an evening game focused on education, a motion was made and passed unanimously to Opt In, permitting club members to play if one wishes to do so.

# **March 2021 Director Reports**

## **Treasurer Report**

For the first two months of 2021 the club showed a loss of -\$870.

February was better than January. In February we had a profit of \$793 compared to the loss of - \$1,663 in January.

February was better than January for two reasons:

- we recorded a fairly large one-time expense paid in January
- payroll and charity donations were lower in February.

We have nearly \$32,600 in CDs and cash in our checking account. This is, in effect, our rainy-day fund.

Overall, our current financial position is <u>favorable</u>. For this reason the Finance Committee, by a split vote recommends, not increasing our BBO game fee from the current base of \$3 per player.
