Director and Officer Reports

Mary Jenkins reported another \$585 loss for the month but overall, because of the tournament, we're ahead \$753. She went over reports of Profit and Loss statements in a format requested by Peggy Ross. Information was also broken out by month.

Alan Trippel, by way of a phone call to Peggy Ross, said that EasyBridge! will begin September 13, the second Thursday. Also Tony Gunn is becoming an accredited teacher and will take the test to be a director. Social bridge is over with 8 players starting and finishing. Pinochle will start another class in August and has been advertised by Teri LaBove.

Andy Cosby stated that Table Count is up about 9.5% over the same period last year. Some members are playing less often than they were a year ago. Out of 616 members only about 340 duplicate players are playing regularly (defined as at least once a month). That's down at least 200 players from 5 years ago.

Teri LaBove said she has advertised for the upcoming tournament and a few people are following the posts on our Facebook page. The scrapbook is now up-to-date.

Annie Dethardt reported we have 616 members and 138 of them are new this year.

Greg Frank said he has had positive feedback on the new Bridge Mates and they are working out well.

Carole Trainer made a motion to adjourn at 4:47, seconded by Mary Jenkins.
