Replaying a Hand


Introduction

You cab replay a hand on screen, using a simple double-dummy (all cards displayed) application, or download a hand (or all hands) to your computer to replay them using your own software.

Playing a hand on screen

This is the simplest method of replaying a hand on a tablet device.

Select the hand you want to play, using the hand numbers on the top right of the screen shown below, or by using the Next / Previous buttons.




To start, click the **Play it again** button.

The first time you do this on a specific device, the following screen will be displayed to set up the viewer:



I normally use BS Online, as this is easiest for a single hand, and requires no software to be installed. So click The **BS Online button**, whereupon the chosen hand will be displayed, as follows:



Click the **Help** button for guidance on getting started:

Start playing a contract interactively by clicking on an entry in the makeable contracts table (including entries shown as '-' or '*')

A button highlighted bright yellow in the makeable contracts table designates the suit/declarer combination actually played in a club game or tournament.

Press the 'Edit' button to edit the hands or change the vulnerability for the board

Press the 'Analyse' button to calculate makeable contracts and optimum contracts/score for the displayed board

The 'Goto...' button allows any board to be selected from the set of boards for the current event

The 'Results Analysis' mode enables you to analyse your performance and card play against double dummy and against other pairs. Click here for more information

CLOSE

It's fairly easy to use, especially if you can find the actual contract played. In other situations, say for example you have ended up in 3NT and this contract is not shown, as above, just click on the 1NT entry and see whether you can make 9 tricks or more.
