

Saving and loading lin.files

- 1 You will find a .lin file for each chapter on your memory stick
- 2 Save the Lin files in the folder with the rest of the information needed for the relevant lesson
- 3 Go to BBO and login
- 4 Click on Account
- 5 Click on deal archive [on the top on my laptop]
- 6 That will bring up any deals you have already put there
- 7 On the line where you see SELECT FOLDER at the other end you will see a +, click on it and you will see Untitled folder
- 8 You will see a pen and trash can on the right, if you click on the pen you can type in the name of your lesson
- 9 Click on the pen again and it will save your named file
- 10 Click on the name again and it will show SELECT DEAL, at the moment nothing is in there.
- 11 At the bottom you will see Import LIN file, click on it
- 12 That will bring up Import Lin File – for some reason the only place you can do this is on the Home Page, ie the page you come to when you first login [there are now 2 servers on BBO and importing only seems possible on the original server]
- 13 The box that appears says Import Lin File
- 14 Select Choose File – click on it
- 15 This takes you back to your files. Find where you have saved the lin file and select it - double click on the lin file
- 16 In the import lin file window you will see beside Choose File the name of the lin file you've imported
- 17 Click on Import – it will then tell you it has imported the file
- 18 Click on the name of the folder in Deal Archive to close it and then reopen it again and hey presto you will then have all the hands you have imported
- 19 To check you have the right hands click on Board 1 and the hand will pop up. You will have been sent a copy of the hands and you can open that and check with the board.
