

Duplimate fund – annual report to March 2026

The fund to cover replacement, maintenance and consumables for the Duplimate machine was established in October 2012. The funds are currently held in a separate savings account within the main Danbury Bridge Circle Bank Account.

At the start of this financial year the fund totalled £4,240.04 During the year the following expenses were incurred:

Cost of replacement bands	£12.22
Cost of full service including P&P	£142.82

Interest of £84.80 was earned during this period so the total of the fund is now £4181.00.

The cost of a replacement machine is currently £3,480.00

No contributions to the fund are currently being made by the clubs making use of the machine and, in view of the current size of the fund it is recommended that no further contributions are made for the time being.

Currently Ted Cockle and Alan Rodger share the task of producing boards for those clubs requiring this service – at present this is only done for Chelmsford, Langdale and Danbury Bridge Circle, although the facility remains available to other clubs if required.
