Key Issues in Bidding Slams

## **SLAM BIDDING**

- We don't bid enough slams
  - a making slam is not the same as a GOOD slam

- We need to recognise slam zone
  - we must take our time, be honest with partner

- When bidding small slam, consider a grand
  - again, taking your time

## **SLAM BIDDING**

The most important tool is

## **SPLINTERS**

 Can apply in all situations where you agree trumps ...

## AGREEING THE FIRST SUIT BID

Standard use of splinters

DOUBLE JUMP over opening bid

- some play single jump as "mini-splinter"
- vital: number 4 on best conventions

#### IN AGREEING SECOND BID SUIT

Same pattern – unnecessary jump

- more often now a SINGLE jump
  - just ask is simple bid forcing
  - if so then jump is splinter (else double jump)

- Agreeing the third bid suit
  - exactly the same pattern (but only in 4<sup>th</sup> suit)

### AFTER AGREEING FIRST SUIT

- After raise of major (1M-P-2M)
  - new suit usually strength/length game try
  - so jump is splinter
- Similarly after 1M-P-2N (Jacoby)
- Same applies after raise of minor
  - but GT priority is keeping 3N in the picture
- After jump raise of a major : no space
  - use 3N to deny a splinter, so that ...
  - any suit bid shows splinter

#### AFTER AGREEING SECOND SUIT

- Major agreed : suit-1M-2M
- Major agreed : suit-1M-3M
  - both exactly as for 1M-raise
  - artificial NT bid allows opener to show shortage

- Minor suit agreed: 1M-2m-3m
  - first focus is when to bid 3N
  - need to jump for splinter

### AFTER AGREEING SECOND SUIT

When transfers are involved ...

- 1N 2 2 3 3 (forcing)
  - (most people) show-er bids out shape
    - here 3S would imply 3514 shape
  - promises shortage in the unbid suit
  - 3N bid would deny any shortage

#### AGREEING THE THIRD SUIT

Direct raises NF

- Only suit left for a jump is the 4<sup>th</sup> suit
  - relatively rare
  - often have to bid 4<sup>th</sup> before support
