Covid 19 and Potential Club Closure.

As I am sure you all realise, it is a matter of when, not if, we have to close the club for an unknown time. As soon as it becomes clear when we have to close I will immediately write an e mail and phone all those not on email. We have postponed the Easter Egg Event and the Charity event, and I don't think our second social teams event will now be taking place.

Financial Situation.

Our Treasurer has been monitoring our finances carefully. In the last 3 months table numbers have gone down a bit, and our WBU subs are due. The club closure will mean no rent, but also no revenue. When we reopen we will need to look again at the situation. We made some decisions about how to save the club money. Wednesday sessions will stop at 10 saving nearly £250 per year. We also will not be funding the 3 league teams entry fees, nor the teams of eight fees from next year. In the end we may have to increase table money, but we will not be deciding that yet.
