The **competition** entry fee is per person for each competition with a discounted cap of £190 per person for the whole Congress. This is a joint Congress with the EBU so EBU credits can be used towards entry fees by emailing EBU direct and asking to use them.

+ If a competition is drawn then the winners' prize money is shared equally between the pairs/teams. If a team/pair has a substitute then the total prize money is shared at the discretion of the pair/team. There are additional prizes available for the best Channel Island pair/team in the Open Pairs, Swiss Pairs, Swiss Teams and across both Swiss events – awarded only at the discretion of the Guernsey CICBA Chair.

* To be eligible for a Seniors prize, both players must have their 63rd birthday (or higher) during January-December 2025.
