Notes from the TD

When is a call made?

Definitions:

A **bid** is a suit denomination and level (eg. 1 •)

A **call** covers all bids and also pass, double and redouble.

A call is considered to have been made when it has been taken from the bidding box with apparent intent.

If an incorrect call is made by mechanical error (i.e. two cards sticking together), the call may be changed -if partner has not yet called.

If in doubt please call the TD.
