We will monitor the numbers playing each week and, if necessary, return to our usual "Members only" policy to ensure that members of Coolagad are not excluded from playing on Monday nights.

Standby available

A committee member will act as standby for the first 6 weeks, but we will be asking members to act as standby as soon as this is practical.

Vaccination certificate

Only fully vaccinated members will be allowed entry so please bring your vaccination certificate with you as this will be checked on the door.

Every player must use their own bidding box. Bidding boxes will be available for purchase in the Bridge Centre at cost price of € 8.

Table money € 5

Table money for normal tournaments will be € 5. Please do not bring any coins.

What is your NBID?

You will need to know your New Bridge ID (NBID) number issued by the CBAI as this will be used to for the Bridgemates. It is on your CBAI membership card and will be listed on the notice board in the Centre.

Refreshments

There will be no tea-break so you might like to bring some refreshment with you. If you do, remember to bring them home as any bottles, etc left behind will be put in the bin at the end of the night.

Masks & Hygiene

Members must wear a mask when moving around the Centre – on arrival, changing tables, going to the toilet – but not when seated. Player should bring personal hand sanitizers and use them after playing each hand to reduce the risk of contaminating the cards and the boards.

The ventilation and heating systems have been serviced and are in full working order. Members are reminded that they are not permitted to meddle with the thermostatic controls on the radiators as this can disturb the heating and ventilation system.

The Centre has also installed air steriliser units which will sterilise the Centre after each session.
