

Crawley Bridge Club (CBC)

GDPR Privacy Notice

Legal Basis. The data referred to below is collected because it is in the legitimate interest of the Club as a membership organisation and participant in an internationally recognised and regulated mind sport.

Data. The Club will collect the following from each member:-

Mandatory contact data Name, Postal Address, Email Address and Telephone Number
Optional data including, but not limited to, Emergency contact details.

We collect the scores from games played which are displayed on our results web page and are sent to the English Bridge Union (EBU).

Storage. Members data is stored electronically by the Secretary. The Secretary is responsible for the security and maintenance of the membership database.

Who is your data shared with? CBC is affiliated to the EBU so that anyone who joins CBC is enrolled in the EBU. The Club acts as data processors on behalf of the EBU to whom they send members' mandatory contact data and game results.

Under no circumstances would CBC pass on member's mandatory contact data to any other third party.

Under no circumstances would CBC pass on member's optional data to any third party.

N.B. CBC holds online sessions as well as club sessions at Grattons Indoor Bowls Club (GIBC). It is a condition of joining CBC that members regularly attending club sessions also join as social members of GIBC. GIBC has its own process for GDPR compliance.

Retention and Maintenance. CBC will seek to retain and maintain the data referred to above for as long as the individual maintains their membership by renewing their annual subscription. If their subscription lapses or they advise the Club of their resignation from membership, the Secretary will delete their records from the database after a period of two years has elapsed.

Compliance. The person responsible for ensuring CBC discharges its obligations under the GDPR is the Secretary.

Data Use. Each member will complete a membership application form by which they specify how the Club can use and communicate their data to other members. There is a range of options from open disclosure to club members to non-use. An electronic copy of membership application forms will be retained and maintained by the Secretary as part of the database. If a member wishes to amend the scope of use for their data they can send a supplementary membership form to the Secretary who will amend the database accordingly.

The Club uses email to advise members of up-coming competitions, items of news and so on. Club emails are distributed in blind copy format.
