Reopening the bidding with strong balanced hands after your partner has passed.

Quite often you open the bidding with a strong balanced hand (15-19 pts) and there is an overcall and partner passes. What action should you take? You hold the hands below and open 1D. 1D-1S- P- P ? **▲**AQ98 ♥876 **♦KQ72** A.J **Pass**, too weak to re-bid 1NT opposite a passed hand, beware 15-17 points is not enough, you need 18-19 points 🕢. **♦**A6 **♥**KQ108 ♦AQ75 **♣**J32 **Double**, it's for take-out (a). Whatever action partner takes is fine! ♦AQ6 **♥**KQ10 ♦AQJ106 ♣98 1NT, perfect, you have a great hand 18-19 points and a double spade stop (). **♦**63 **♥**AKJ3 **♦KQJ**9 ♣A65 **Double**, takeout 18 pts but no spade stop, no other option \mathfrak{S} .

Bidding in the re-opening seat playing a weak No-trump system is important because we won't have a weak NT hand but are often strong balanced when the situation comes up 🐑.

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
