

## ACBL VISITOR POLICY FOR VIRTUAL GAMES

The American Contract Bridge League (ACBL) has a “Visitor” policy which includes guidelines for how many Visitors may play in our Virtual games.

A Visitor is defined as someone who **has not played** at a particular club in a face-to-face club game from January 2019 through February 2020. Sectional Tournaments held at a club do not count as club games because they are ACBL events.

The ACBL's policy allows visitors as long as the visitors at the club's virtual games make up no more than 15% of the total attendance each week. Therefore, we must now keep track of visiting players. We would love to be able to admit all of our friends to play in our virtual games, but in order for the DMBC to stay in compliance with ACBL's policy, we must ask everyone to help us meet the ACBL's criteria.
