We opened for Face to Face games on Monday April 5.

We request that you be fully vaccinated at least 2 weeks prior to your first 'play date' at the club.

The initial schedule of games **at the club** starting April 5 is:

MONDAY 1:00 - An Open and a Limited (499er) game provided there are enough tables for two sections. If not, we will have one section. **Please arrive by 12:40** so we can complete the verification process and start the game on time. Please email mwirutis@cfl.rr.com to confirm you play to play.

WEDNESDAY 9:30 - 499er game preceded by $\frac{1}{2}$ lesson starting at 9:00. **Please arrive by 8:40**. Please email johnedietz@gmail.com to let him know you plan to be there.

FRIDAY 6:30 - SWISS TEAM Game. Sign up required. Please call or email John Dietz to confirm your attendance. johnedietz@gmail.com or 720-548-0079. **Please arrive by 6:10**.

The **ONLINE VIRTUAL GAME** schedule is revised as follows:

FRIDAY 1:15 - OPEN GAME (MEMBERS ONLY)

NEW INFO: Due to limited space in rest rooms, we will not have organized breaks, but will adjust clock to 8 minutes per board so personal breaks can be taken as needed.

Reminder: the following will apply to all Face to Face games.

1. Players must have been fully vaccinated at least two weeks before entering the club.

2. In accordance with CDC Guidelines, masks are strongly encouraged. If requested by other players at the table, you will be expected to wear a mask. You may purchase a mask at the club if you forget one.
3. No food will be served or permitted in the club.
4. Drinks will not be served in the club. This includes coffee and bottled water. You may bring your own drink in a covered container but no drinks at the tables.
5. Please be prepared with exact change or Prepaid Tickets for game fees. Still \$6.00 most games.
6. Hand sanitizers will be provided at each table and throughout the room - though you are encouraged to bring your own personal sanitizer. Please use them before each board is played. And at other times when appropriate.
7. Bidding boxes will move with E/W players. You may label a bidding box as your own. A table will be set up in the back of the room for 'personalized' bidding boxes.
8. Bridgemates will be handled by only one person at the table. North (or South) will enter the scores, verify the score with E/W and then enter OK.
9. No hand records will be available. They are available on our website and through The Common Game.
10. Duplicate Boards will rest for a week or two between uses.

The club will be cleaned and sanitized after each playing day.

We will also be installing more robust HEPA filters in the A/C units.

For the time being the refrigerators will not be available to the members, and the water fountain will be turned off. We apologize for the inconvenience of these 'restrictions' but we are complying as best we can with the current CDC guidelines for our situation.
