THE SHIRLEY TOWNLEY 0-299 AWARD

The name of the 0-299 player who has won the most points at DMBC during a calendar year will be inscribed on the plaque. The following are the criteria for winning.

1. The winner must begin the calendar year with less than 299 points per the DMBC and ACBL data bases on January 1.
2. Only points earned at DMBC games and Sectionals held at DMBC during the calendar year will be counted.
3. The winners must be paid members of DMBC and ACBL per the DMBC and ACBL data bases the entire calendar year January 1 - December 31.
4. More than one player can win, and a player can win more than once. The winner(s) of this award will be honored with a party held in January at a date to be determined by the club manager. There will always be a coconut cake served at that party.
