## **FAST TRACK COURSE IN BRIDGE**

The course aims to take you to a basic standard of bridge in just 10 lessons. Short self-study exercises (in both digital and printed format) will be provided for use at home to aid the learning in lessons. The teaching is mainly practically based with card-based exercises, interspersed with short expositions. Individual guidance during the lesson will be given. There will be one or more helpers in addition to the teacher. The Fast Track course is designed for people who are not able to attend a weekday daytime course and wish to have a shorter course. This shorter course is achieved by having a faster pace and making available some self study materials to use between lessons.

**Cost**: £80 for 10 lessons. Full time students pay £40. Handouts and links to digital resources will be made available, so a course book is optional. Refund after lesson 1 if not satisfied. For anyone with some prior playing experience, we could offer starting at Lesson 2 for a reduced fee of £72 (but most people like to be in at the beginning)

**Time**: 10 lessons on **Saturday** morning 10.00 - 12.30, starting **11**<sup>th</sup> **January** and ending on the **14**<sup>th</sup> **March**. Includes a short refreshment break with free drink and biscuits.

## **Question and Answer**

Q. Will I be able to keep up?

A. Because the course has a practical basis, you will to a large extent be able to learn at your own pace.

Q. What if I miss a lesson?

Because we will be constantly revising and practising what has been done, you will get the opportunity to catch up. Also printed handouts and quizzes can be given for the missed lessons.

Q. Can I park at the club?

A. Whilst we do not have on site parking, there is parking nearby. The Devonshire Park car park is the nearest 4 hour parking and costs £2.60, and it is in College Road at BN21 4JJ. The nearest free parking is in parts of Blackwater Road or Saffrons.

Q What can I do at the end of the course?

A. Play social bridge or play club duplicate bridge in an improvers group.

Q Do I need to have played any bridge or card games before?

A. No we start from the beginning and assume no prior knowledge
