t is easy to see \P competition from North-South pushing the opponents into a thin 4 contract that they may not have bid left to their own devices. North-South have a good favourable save in 5 (two off, -300) against their opponents' game but I can't see too many pairs finding it as each of their nands has defensive cards in it. On closer inspection, they may be better off not finding the save as 4 needs a very good view in the play. Say North leads a \P . Declarer wins and plays a \clubsuit to the J and a second round of \clubsuit s to North's A. North switches to a small \blacklozenge . Declarer has real difficulty in getting back to hand to draw the last trump. In fact, the only way is to play \blacklozenge A and then duck a \oiint ! Now South can cash \blacklozenge K but has to give declarer a ruff and discard in \P to get back to hand to draw the last trump.

Many Acol players open the higher of two four card suits but both majors should be an exception to make it easy to find a fit in a major. In the auction above South checks back for a 5-3 \checkmark fit after the game-forcing 2NT rebid. The trouble with this auction is it makes \clubsuit s, his side's weak spot, the unbid suit. On a \clubsuit lead, West can either duck the lead completely or win the Q and return a low card to maintain communication with his partner. With no ruffing value there is much to be said for South directly raising to 3NT, and now East might try a \bigstar , the unbid major, letting in an overtrick. I can't see many pairs reaching a double dummy par four major contract.

Over a weak NT, North may be able to intervene for example with 2 \triangleq showing \forall s and a second suit. This should also lead to $4 \triangleq$, maybe sometimes played by West when East has made a transfer bid.

4♠ should normally make 11 tricks. Declarer should play ace and a ♥ to set up his ruff before drawing trumps. When West is declarer the defence is slightly more difficult. North will lead a top ♦ and will have to avoid switching to a ♥ which would gift declarer a twelfth trick.

One of those hands where both sides are likely to unearth their major suit and it will be a question of who gives in. \blacklozenge contracts can be held to eight tricks, providing West does not lead the \blacktriangleleft A, the suit his partner has bid. East-West aren't going to bid 4♥ without being pushed into and it is not a good contract. On many layouts the defence will be able to organise a \clubsuit ruff, \P s may have a loser or the \blacklozenge finesse may fail, but here none of that is true. Say South leads a \bigstar against a \P contract. Declarer wins and play \P Q, which South does best not to cover. The bidding may well suggest that North has length in both black suits, so declarer should continue with \P J, picking up the suit. He can draw the last trump and then work on \clubsuit s, but will have to lose 3 tricks in the suit when it splits 5-0.

East, vulnerable, will have to be careful that he does not step out of line getting too high with his attractive hand. Against a \clubsuit contract South will lead a \bigstar , to the K, A and 2 (\blacklozenge suit preference). East ruffs with the Ten and South discards. When South gets in with \bigstar K, he can play a \blacklozenge to North's ace and now another round of \bigstar s promotes South's 8 securing +200 for the defence and a good score.

In the auction above, South shows his \P fit and North carries his side to game. West lead a \clubsuit to the Ace and now East has to cash the \P A to defeat the game. Declarer sets up the \clubsuit suit but has to lose two more \P to West's Q and T. On a \blacklozenge return, say, one of the trump tricks goes away. Declarer plays \clubsuit AK, ruffs a \clubsuit Kc, ruff a \clubsuit , \bigstar ruff, \blacklozenge ruff, \bigstar and the defence can only score two trumps tricks.

North might try 3 + (invitational) at his second turn showing his long suit or 2NT showing his double stop in the unbid suit. South with only 12 HCP and a misfit for his partner's suit should be passing whatever North bids although some may try 3NT on the basis that partner is unlikely to make 3 +. In fact, 3 + can make, with 2 losers in the black suits, declarer can make his contract as long as he loses no more than two trumps, which he does by playing the DK on either the first or second round of the suit to squash one of East's honours. After a \checkmark lead, 3NT makes in a similar way by setting up the \Rightarrow suit for the loss of 2 tricks and then guessing to play a \pm to the T. The alternative and probably more attractive line of playing on \oplus s will fail when both honours are offside.

When West opens with a **Y** pre-empt North will likely drive his side to game in a minor. 5 only has two top losers but declarer can't survive the bad breaks. West probably starts by cashing his aces and plays a second \bigstar say. Declarer ruffs in dummy, and suspects because of the pre-empt that he can't enjoy the ♥s without drawing three rounds of trumps, so he plays ♣A and ruffs a . He crosses to table on a trump and ruffs another . At this point declarer should realise he can't set up and enjoy the s, so the best he can do is to continue cross-ruffing which leaves him a trick short (9 \blacklozenge and the \clubsuit A). I suppose some Wests with 2 aces may open at the one level, leaving North to show his minors at lower level with 2NT. In this scenario some pairs will

play a \blacklozenge partial or maybe even 3NT which can make after a low \blacklozenge lead and some inspired views in the play.

South has a clear opening in third seat, if nothing else for the lead directional value should his partner end up on lead.

If West chances a modern style double of the 1♥ then East-West will probably play a minor suit part score. This should make somewhere between 8 and 10 tricks depending on how good declarer is at guessing the location on the AQ and \clubsuit J. If West passes I suppose North-South might play one of $1 \bigstar$, 1NT or $2 \heartsuit$, and as long as declarer doesn't go more than 2 off in those contracts he should earn his side a reasonable score.
