

Appeals Process

The committee has agreed a process for handling appeals against directors' rulings.

These points supersede all relevant parts of the laws of the game:

- Appeals – which may be from either member of a pair – need to be lodged with the director or a member of the committee by noon on the day following the director's ruling
- The director or committee member will pass the case to a referee who is suitably-qualified to deal with it. This will usually be an experienced director, though discipline issues may need to be handled by a senior committee member
- The referee's decision will be final and the club will not engage in any further discussion on the case
