RESERVES A list of reserves (willing to be contacted if you are short for a particular match) will be sent separately to Captains when available.
Captains may also invite players who are not members of Farnham bridge club to play in up to two matches for their teams.

## MATCH ARRANGEMENTS

Captains are responsible for contacting each other to agree a suitable date and number of boards (default is 24 , with both captains agreement this can be reduced to 20 boards). The default platform is REALBRIDGE and all REALBRIDGE costs are included in the team entry fee. Teams may however mutually agree to play on an alternative platform or face to face; any additional cost incurred are then up to the teams to pay. Captains, please be aware that a number of teams will NOT be able to play face-to-face, due to health reasons and/or including distant partners.
REALBRIDGE matches need to be set up a few days in advance by a Farnham Bridge club REALBRIDGE director. If you do not have an FBC REALBRIDGE director playing in the match, contact Mike O'Donnell, Gabriel Hearst, Hilary Havelock or Simon Foale, to set up the match and link for you. Captains will be sent a list of email addresses for all other captains, plus instructions on how to play a team's match on REALBRIDGE.

## A \& B DIVISION SCHEDULE

There is a 3 week range for each match, but teams are encouraged to play their matches on the middle Mon, Tues or Wed of this range, to reduce the organisation burden on Captains.

## FINALS AND PLATE COMPOSITION

The top 3 teams from each division will go forward to the Finals, the rest will play in the Plate competition. In the final, you will play only against those that qualified from the other division.

## REPORTING RESULTS

The winning captain in each game should email Simon Foale (simonjohnfoale@gmail.com)
and Mike O'Donnell (Mike@lizandmike.co.uk) with (1)the result, (2) the members of each team who played (for match point/NGS purposes) and (3) the number of boards played. A table of results and standings will be posted and updated weekly on the FBC website.

## LATE STARTS AND DEFAULTS

If a team fails to turn up on the date agreed, or is more than 30 minutes late, then that team automatically loses the match and scores zero Victory Points (VPs). The VP score of the non-offending team is the highest of the following:
a) Average of the 'winners' scores for all division or finals matches, rounded to the highest number (eg 11.1 becomes 12)
b) The minimum win (i.e 11-9)
c) The average of the 'losers' scores deducted from the maximum win (i.e 20) and rounded to the highest number

If a team arrives up to 30 minutes late, or if one team is excessively slow, the other team may insist on a reduction in the number of boards played in a match. (A reasonable maximum time for a 24 board match is 2 hour 30 minutes).
In the event of a team withdrawing from the league part-way throught the competition, the team defaults all its matches.
