A.G.M. 2020 Minutes.... There were no matters arising from the 2020 minutes, copies of which were on every table.

Treasurers Report. This was given by Tom. The balance as at 31st January 2022 is £1080.07. He then explained the report saying at this time the club had sustained a loss of £480.97 since reopening.

This was due to the room hire, insurance and costs for the Bridge tabs & Bridge Webs. Also some new equipment since the reopening.

Joany asked about possibly getting an EBU grant. There are none available at this present time & they have to be for something specific.

There being no further questions regarding the report it was proposed as being correct by Joany & seconded by Lesley.

Chair Report Steve asked everyone to read the report, copies of which were on the table, There were no questions regarding the report.

Election of Officers.....There were no new nominations. The current officers are happy to continue as are the current committee members.

Fees. Due to the lack of funds it has been proposed that the membership fee remains at £5. per year and weekly table money increases to £4 .
