This is my third year as Chair of Great Yarmouth Bridge Club (GYBC) and it seems to have passed rather quickly. Looking back, I am pleased with what we have achieved so far. Luckily for me, the key members involved in the smooth operational running of the club, Cheryl, Tom, Lesley, Anne & Nick have stayed in post which meant that the Club has continued to be run efficiently and without incident.
