Minutes No matter arising from previous minutes Proposed by JT. 2nd LS.

Treasurers Report: TH stated that there is £2835.47 in the bank with £630 to be paid in & other than EBU bill of £93, there are no further outstanding bills. JT asked at what point is too much money for a non-profit organisation. He as assured that we were not at that point.

Chair Report: Teams event went well, 9 tables in all. SH thanked JT & RR for their help in organising this event. A similar event is proposed for a date to be set in October. Bridge Score, the new system is now in place. It has been proved to be much easier to use and set up.

SH said that the new lap top cost £330, and a new router was £60. With this new equipment all the tablets are working well, SH is proposing not to change the tablets now, but the situation will be monitored.

Slow play continues to be monitored, and, in certain circumstances, the Tournament Director reserves the right to award an average to slow players. Committee continues to support this decision.

Membership: We now have 57 paid up members and have had up to 12 tables playing. SH is reluctant to put a block on membership numbers, so the list will stay open for now but will be monitored.

Noise level within the bar area is out of our control, It has been too hot to close the doors, but with cooler weather they can be closed if necessary.

Has been approached bu JB who wanted to buy 2 uplighters for the club. He was told thanks but not an option. No storage at the club or facilities for recharging them. JT has asked the club manager if the dining room lights could be made brighter. This is something that will be changed later in the year No further business.
