Major Suit Opening Bids

Requirements for opening with a major suit at the one level:

- a) 13+ HCP (counting for length)
- b) 5+ cards in the suit

Responses to a major suit opening bid:

- a) Pass with 0-5 HCP
- b) Raise partner with support (at least 3 or more cards in the suit)
 - 1. Single raise- 6-9 HCP
 - 2. Jump raise- 10-12 HCP
 - 3. Raise to game- 13+ HCP
- c) Bid a new suit at the 2 level- 10+ HCP and at least four cards in the suit (1H-P-2C)
- d) Bid a new suit at the 1 level- 6+ HCP and at least four cards in the suit (1H-P-1S)
- e) Rebid NT without support for partner's suit
 - 1. 1NT- 6-9 HCP
 - 2. 2NT- 10-12 HCP
 - 3. 3NT- 13-15 HCP

Somethings to remember:

- a) With 6 or more HCP you should respond with some bid. Do not pass, as partner could have enough for game.
- b) Raises and NT responses all have upper limits, so opener may pass.

- c) A new suit response has no upper limit. Therefore, opener must make another bid.
- d) With both major suits of five cards each open with 1S.

What would you open the bidding with the following?

- a) J7654 AKQ6 K87 9
- b) AK A76542 8765 9
- c) AKQJ 876 A3 8765
- d) AQ876 KJ7 AQ76 8
- e) 98 KJ765 AQJ87 9

What would you respond after 1H-P-?

- a) 987 Q87 A765 876
- b) K7 76 A8765 9876
- c) Q543 76 87 KJ765
- d) 987 Q87 A765 AJ8
- e) 76 J7 AQ765 K872
