
BBO INSTRUCTIONS

SELF ALERTING ON BBO

The one big difference between playing at a bridge table in a club and playing online with BBO is that your partner <u>must not</u> alert any conventional bids you play as a partnership.


With BBO, <u>you</u> must alert your conventional bids when you are bidding <u>and</u> give a brief explanation as to what it means. The correct sequence is that you press Alert and type in your explanation <u>in the middle</u> of what you are bidding eg

If you wish to make a 2H (weak) opening bid then you hit the '2' button – then hit 'Alert' – then key-in your explanation – then hit the 'Heart' button.



BIDDING A 2H (weak) BID

The Alert and Explanation are only seen by the opponents $\underline{\text{and not}}$ by your partner.



The opposition will see the 2H in a red rectangle meaning an Alert. The explanation will appear on the screen also.



Your partner will only see the 2H bid.

The SBU have issued guidelines stating that "all conventions must be alerted, including doubles (that are not for penalties), at all levels including 3N and above".

If you <u>forget to alert</u> then <u>click on</u> your bid asap. This opens up a box into which you can type an explanation. Your explanation is displayed only to the opposition.

Bids alerted by the opposition will be visible to you outlined in red. <u>To query an opponent's bid, click on it</u> and they will be prompted to provide an explanation or a fuller explanation.

A FEW MORE EXAMPLES OF ALERTING COMMON CONVENTIONAL BIDS

Your partner has opened 1NT and you wish to bid 2C (stayman):

<u>Click</u> the 2 button – then <u>click</u> Alert – then <u>key-in</u> 'Stayman' – then <u>click</u> the Club button

Your partner has opened 1NT and with 5 Spades you wish to transfer your partner:

 \underline{Click} the 2 button – then \underline{click} Alert – then $\underline{key\text{-in}}$ 'Transfer' – then \underline{click} the Heart button

During the bidding you find a fit in Spades so you wish to ask for Aces (Blackwood) so you bid:

<u>Click</u> the 4 button – then <u>click</u> Alert – then <u>key-in</u> 'Blackwood' – then <u>click</u> the NT button
