DID YOU KNOW?

<u>Tippling</u>. Is it legal? Is it permitted?

Leaving a bidding card slanted to remind the player of the current contract is reassuring and helpful to learners and novices.

Law 40B2(d) states that: "Unless the Regulating Authority provides otherwise a player is not entitled to any aids to his memory, calculation or technique during the auction period and play."

However, Law 41C:"... After it is too late to have previous calls restated (see B), declarer or either defender, at his own turn to play, is entitled to be informed as to what the contract is and whether, but not by whom, it was doubled or redoubled. "

These days, playing online, the contract is displayed throughout the card play.

Some years ago I asked a national TD if this meant that tippling was lawful, the informal opinion was yes.

The position each teacher and club takes is up to them.
I allow players to tipple during lessons, practice and gentle bridge.
Of course I remind them occasionally that they will not be able to do this when representing England at European level.

Teachers and clubs need to be clear on this. In my view this separates teachers and clubs that are welcoming to learners and novices from those that put the strictest interpretation of the laws and regulations first
