

How to Access the Video Conference AGM

The HBA AGM on 20th September at 12 noon will be hosted on the ZOOM videoconferencing service. Ideally members wishing to attend should have use of a computer with a web camera and sound. This can be a desktop PC, laptop or tablet. The webcam is not absolutely necessary but without it you'll appear as a black rectangle with your name rather than a live picture. If you have none of these devices it is possible to connect with a mobile smartphone (you'll incur charges unless you have a wifi connection to internet) or even a regular telephone line where the cost of a local call would be incurred.

We are hoping that most of you are already familiar with the use of this sort of videoconference. If you are not ZOOM provides lots of video tutorials you can consult.
