Over responder's redouble:- 2 = 2-2 in majors; other bids to play. Over opener's redouble:- pass = happy to be in it; 2 = 2-2 weak take-out preferring the minors; 2 = 2-2 weak take-out with 2 = 2-2 weak take-out preferring the minors; 2 = 2-2 weak take-out with 2 = 2-2 weak
- 2. Double for penalties; immediate bid non-forcing; 2NT forcing 3C, then a bid is invitational.
