Change to Nonagenarian (90+) Free Play Policy: The policy providing free play for 90+ players began as a tribute to those who helped establish JSOB and who maintained a long-term commitment. We are a growing club. Many new members are already approaching age 90, and they do not meet the long-term commitment criterion that was an implicit part of the original policy. The Board of Directors has updated the policy effective January 18, 2024, grandfathering in all who are presently 90+ and extending it to all who attain the age of 90+ and who have been a dues-paying member for at least 10 years.
