




# Ever wondered how 007 outsmarted the cunning Sir Hugo Drax in a high-stakes game of bridge?

In Ian Fleming's novel "Moonraker", 007 engages in a game of bridge with the notorious multi-millionaire Sir Hugo Drax. The tale unfolds when M tasks Bond with the mission of delving into Sir Hugo's considerable triumphs at M's cherished bridge club (this is from the James Bond book, although I think it was changed to a Canasta game for the film).

It is during this investigation that Bond uncovers Drax's deceitful tactics. Drax cunningly gazes at the mirrored surface of his glossy cigarette case while dealing the cards, thus gaining an unfair advantage.

Playing with M as his partner, Bond fixes the deck against Drax in the final deal of the session:



Bond, South, deals and opens 7 clubs! When the bidding gets to Drax he obviously doubles. Bond, as you might expect, redoubles.

The Jack of Diamonds is led. Bond ruffs the diamond lead in dummy and then finesses the clubs having gathered much information from the double by Drax. Following that, he ruffs another diamond in dummy and finesses clubs again. Every card in Bond's hand is now a winner and Drax is apoplectic.

On any other lead (hearts or spades), Bond would ruff in his own hand and then cross to Dummy with a diamond ruff where he would finesse the clubs as before.







Competitive Bidding - Feb 2023

In this lesson you'll learn how to use takeout doubles, overcalls, jump overcalls, and improve your competitive bidding arsenal.

That means, after you learn the techniques we'll cover, you can open the door to think like a much better player, in just mere hours! It's an incredible valuable skill that anyone can learn and use during all future games.

- · Which thinking habits you, as third hand, must have after the opening lead is made?
- · What is a negative discard, and why they are so important at No Trump?
- Before returning partner's suit, why and how to count declarer's tricks?

## Ducking by Declarer in Suit Contracts (Jun 2022)

You know that, most of the time, the fate of the hand is determined by how you play to the first trick. That's why many contracts can be won or lost because of that first trick.

Some of the things that you will learn in this lesson:

- There's one outstanding difference with ducking plays in suit contracts, you need to know exactly when trumps must be drawn (and what happens if you don't do it!).
- What are the 3 main reasons for making a ducking play in a suit contract.
- Why some hands can be made if you duck the first trick and win the second, while strangely enough the contract cannot be made if you win the first trick.

And much, much more! We'll play each hand twice. One without ducking, and again, the same hand ducking. Then you can easily see what happens in each case.

The 90-minute lesson includes a handout of all the hands (with commentary from Eddie Kantar).
