

2023 ACBL District and Unit Races... Results Are In!

The ACBL keeps a database of the performance of all its members. It updates the database monthly (usually on the 6th of the following month) and uses a computer program to keep track of how each member qualifies for mention in three races: the Helen Shanbrom Ace of Clubs, the Mini-McKenney, and the Ace of Virtual Clubs.

- ♣ The Helen Shanbrom Ace of Clubs tallies how many masterpoints are won by each individual when playing F2F games at a club level.
- ◆ The Mini-McKenney tracks how many points are won by an individual when playing F2F games at a club and at tournaments.
- ▼ The Ace of Virtual Clubs tallies how many points are won by an individual when playing in any online club game.



2023 ACBL District and Unit Races... How Do They Work?

Each ACBL member starts the year in a masterpoint category, and then their Masterpoint winnings for the entire year are tracked. At the end of the year, their winnings are compared with all the other players who started the year in the same masterpoint category. The scores are broken down further so that members of a particular District or members of a particular Unit are compared.

KDBC is in District 1 (comprising all of eastern Canada and shown in pale green on the upper right of the map below—it's a huge District!) and is part of Unit 192 (which covers south-eastern Ontario and Gatineau, Quebec) within District 1.

These club champions are recognized at the unit level and ACBL-wide. All points won at the club level are counted in this contest with the exception of those won in STaCs. This award was renamed in 2011 in honor of Grand Life Master Helen Shanbrom of Tamarac FL. Shanbrom was one of the most active players in the ACBL for decades and won the top category of the Ace of Clubs more times than any other member in ACBL history. (source: ACBL)
