<u>Entry Fees</u> – the individual online game fees were increased to \$5 on 9 Jan 23 to offset the extra table fees that ACBL was going to charge. Once we realized in February that the amount would not be as great as expected, we lowered the entry fees for regular games back down to \$4.

<u>ACBL Table Fees</u> increased in January to \$1.10 US with an exchange rate charge of \$1.36 resulting in a fee of \$1.496 CDN per table. The Junior Fund games had an additional charge of \$4 US per table for a total of \$6.936 CDN per table. Because we were able to pool with two F2F clubs – Pembrooke and Shakespeare's Elbow in Montreal – we did not incur any extra table fees.

<u>Free Plays</u> Each time a member paid their entry fee at a F2F game in January, they were given a free play to be redeemed by the end of February. A total of 105 free plays were given out in January for a total value of \$840.

51 were redeemed in January for a Free Play expense of \$408.

80 free plays have been redeemed as of 15 Feb 23.

**Book Inventory** – New 2/1 Books and Cheat Sheets were purchased from Barbara Seagram in January. As the books are sold, the cost will be removed from inventory and recorded as an expense.
