The Club was holding a team game that year, but Dennis was not feeling well and decided not to play. Then at the last minute he changed his mind, but all the teams were already formed. However, 3 newer players were available (Ilona Ahrens, Assunta Gerretsen and Tara Oberai), so Dennis partnered with them, and their team beat everyone! It was a happy event, and the Club was very excited for the winners. Sadly, Dennis died later that year.

Terry Demers, who was the new Club manager at the time, liked the idea of holding an annual team game that had one pair of newer players teaming up with a pair of more experienced players. Terry approached Dennis' family to see if they would purchase a trophy and they agreed. It is great to see the club mingling and especially joyful to see which team wins – the newer players always playing a big part in the victory.

ALERT, ALERT...ANOTHER FRIENDLY REMINDER

Directors are noticing that some players (often those who are experienced in both bridge and BBO) are still being a tad slack when it comes to alerting bids. **PLEASE:**

- make your alert before you make your bid, and always include a full description of what your bid means at the same time (don't just click the "alert" button and wait for the ops to ask for an explanation). Some common missed alerts include:
- ⇒ alerting your 1NT opening range, even if it is 15-17 hcp
- ⇒ alerting the meaning of your interfering bids over the ops 1NT openings

ALSO PLEASE:

- register for the game with your partner at least 15 minutes before Game Time.
- make sure you and your partner are both on-line and on BBO at least 5 minutes prior to Game Time. THANK YOU!
