Some info on Charity Games – including for the minutes

ACBL holds ACBL Wide Charity Games in March and April. These are optional - you can hold one, two or none. They have extra black and you pay higher ACBL table fees. \$7.45 US per table.

As listed in the email below, there are other fund games across 5 months that you may or may not hold.

Above that you may hold Local Charity Games.... one per sanction per month in the 7 other months... set up in ACBLscore as such, paying higher table fees. \$5.15 per table. BUT you may not hold more of these Local Charity Games that you hold extra fund/charity games. So in a month if you hold one Local Charity game you must hold one fund game. For the Local Charity games, the Club Manager must remember to go into where they pay game fees and adjust the settings for donations on that game so that we will not be charged a higher table fee and we keep and give the extra little bit to our local charity.

I had a long conversation with Sherry Terraciano at ACBL to get these clarifications. Her boilerplate email is below.

Holding a Local Charity Game and not holding an extra fund game is penalizable by ACBL. When we apply for our annual sanctions we agree to comply with all their rules and stipulations.

I think our Christmas Charity fundraising was not entered in ACBLscore as a Charity Game (Is that correct Don?).... we just collected money and sent it... That means ACBL is not aware... and our players didn't get the extra black, we did not have to pay higher table fees and make the adjustment in the payments for donations etc.... So we bypassed the system which she seemed to say was ok but she couldn't understand why we would want to do that.
