THE "TEN COMMANDMENTS" OF GOOD PARTNERSHIP BRIDGE

- Take immediate responsibility for individual mistakes; capitalize on them to improve your game.
- Never embarrass your partner at the table.
- Go on to the next hand; discuss disasters later when emotions subside and perspective returns.
- Limit discussions during the game to simple clarifications.
- Consult acknowledged experts on differences of opinion; give your hand, not your partner's.
- Stick to understandings reached as if they were gospel.
- Always trust your partner over the opponents.
- Share key decisions with your partner as opposed to making unilateral ones.
- Respect your partner's judgement; don't second guess your partner.
- Be sensitive to your partner's needs at the table and be responsive to your partner's signals.
