Treasurer's Report on the accounts for the year ended 31st March 2019

The accounts for the year show a small surplus of £105.81. The decline in income was offset by a decrease in expenditure, mainly due to fact that there were no courses held during the year.

While costs gradually increase, the county's P2P income from the EBU is still declining, due the decreasing membership of the affiliated clubs in the county. However, the decline is very slow and there is not yet any need to ask for an increase in Kent's P2P charge.

The committee continues to promote Bridge by raising awareness of Kent's activities, supporting teaching courses and supporting Bridge in schools. A new expense incurred during the year was a sponsorship contribution of £500 made to the Southern Counties Junior Bridge Camp,
