Treasurer's Report on the accounts for the year ended 31st March 2022

The Monthly Pay-to-Play income continued to recover during the year, as more clubs either adopted on-line play or restarted Face-to-Face sessions. The overall income from competitions held during the year was similar to that in the previous year. The decline in popularity of the regular Saturday competitions was offset by three Virtual Improvers events, two held on behalf of the EBU.

Expenditure was the same as last year, with the addition of a payment of £500 towards the Junior Bridge Camp, which was not held in 2021.

The Kent Contract Bridge Association has come through a difficult period in a sound financial position.
