

# MAKING REALBRIDGE A GOOD EXPERIENCE FOR ALL

I received some feedback from those who played on 19<sup>th</sup> December.

Although RealBridge is clearly more sociable it will take a little getting used to – but people seem by the end of the session they did. The platform is creating the same atmosphere as playing at a 'Real Table'

Doing the following would help everyone enjoy the event.....

- In Chat... give a system summary at the start of each round (CTRL C to copy, CTRL V to paste)
- Microphones are sensitive so try to play in a quiet room. Background noises are very distracting. Try to keep mobile phones on silent, and barking dogs and non-playing partners away. You can mute yourself if any background noise appears e.g. delivery, phone call (but phones should be on silent) and you can reduce the volume of other players.
- Use Google Chrome or Edge – you get a faster connection (try to avoid Safari)
- If your WIFI is poor, try turning off your camera for the rest of the hand
