Doing the following would help everyone enjoy the event.....

- In Chat... give a system summary at the start of each round (CTRL C to copy, CTRL V to paste)
- Microphones are sensitive so try to play in a quiet room. Background noises are very distracting. Try to keep mobile phones on silent, and barking dogs and non-playing partners away.
- Use Google Chrome or Edge – you get a faster connection (try to avoid Safari)
- If your WIFI is poor, try turning off your camera for the rest of the hand
